Reconnect

Reconnect assists youth 13-19 years old who are facing challenges staying connected to their families and communities.

Youth workers promote a safe, healthy lifestyle while strengthening these connections, through prevention and harm reduction strategies.

Reconnect promotes an integrated community approach while helping youth identify, build and use their developmental assets (*positive self-esteem, strengthening family communication, school engagement etc*).



Youth Services

1 on 1 Youth Mentoring

- promote self-esteem and sense of purpose
- encourage safe and healthy lifestyle choices (*drug awareness, sexual health, peer relationships*)
- assist youth in finding or maintaining appropriate school options
- support positive family engagement
- provide positive role modeling
- promote healthy life skills
- support youth living independently
- support parents
- make referrals to a variety of agencies and services
- support youth advocacy
- enable youth in employment search

Street Outreach

- engage youth on their own territory to build relationships
- raise awareness of Alexandra Neighbourhood House and other community services
